#### Introduction

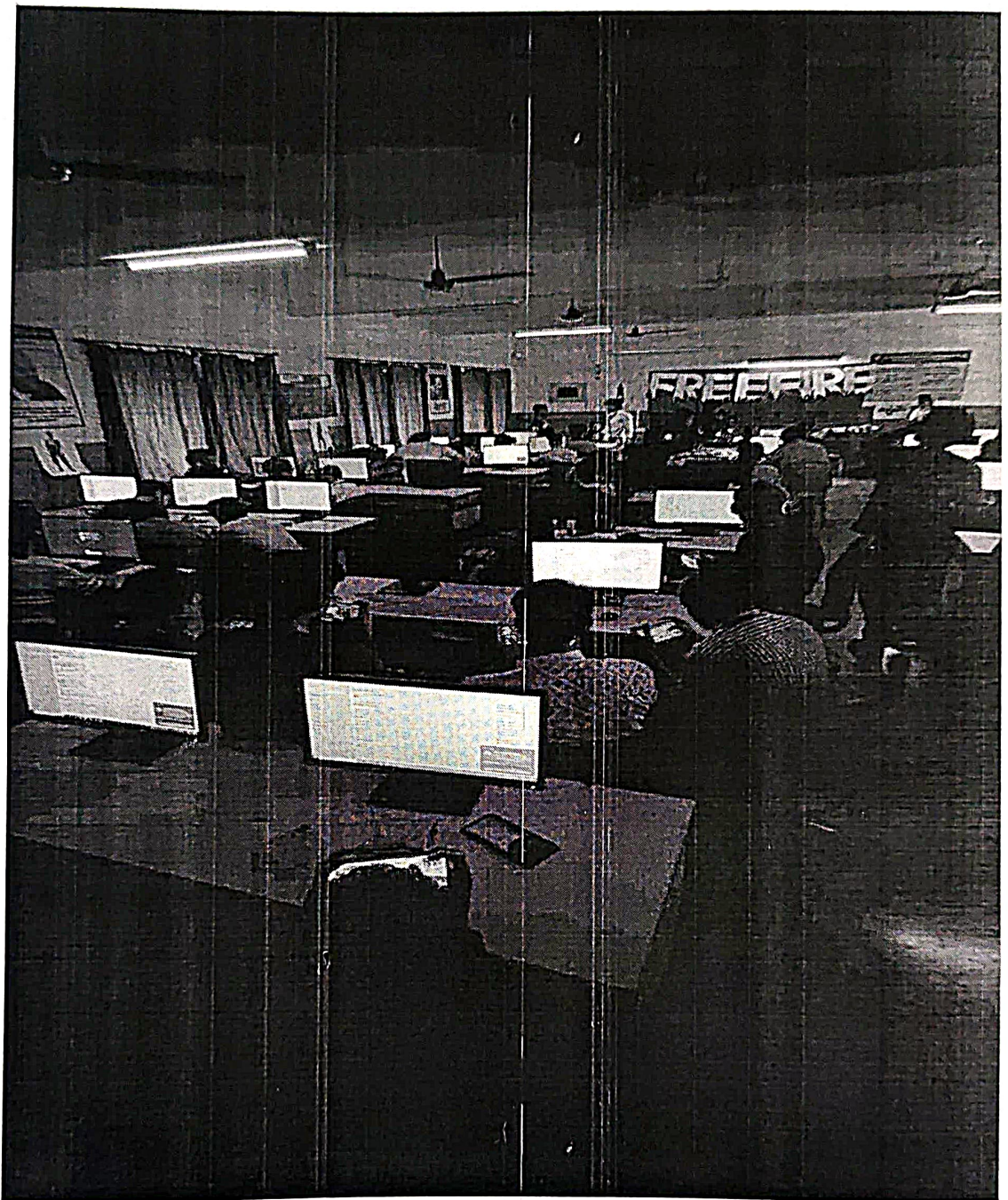
The Sophisticated and Perpetual Coder's Association (SPCA) organized two major events—a Free Fire Competition and an Escape Room Challenge—on 22nd December 2025. These events were held simultaneously across Lab 1, Lab CCA, CCB, and Lab 5. The objective was to provide a diverse platform where students could showcase a wide range of skills, from the fast-paced strategic reflexes required in e-sports to the analytical and logical thinking needed for complex problem-solving. By hosting these twin events, SPCA aimed to foster teamwork, mental agility, and a spirit of healthy competition among the students.

#### Main Event

The day witnessed a massive surge of energy as participants split between the two high-intensity zones:

- **Free Fire Competition (Lab 1, 1st Floor):** This e-sports segment focused on tactical coordination and survival skills. Teams battled in virtual arenas, demonstrating impressive communication and quick decision-making. The atmosphere was competitive and spirited, with participants utilizing advanced gaming strategies to outperform their rivals.
- **Escape Room Competition (Lab CCA, CCB, and Lab 5):** In this segment, the labs were transformed into themed puzzle rooms. Participants worked in groups to decode riddles, solve cryptographic challenges, and unlock

logic-based sequences to "escape" within the time limit. This event tested the participants' patience, attention to detail, and ability to work under pressure.





From 11.15am to 4.15pm, the venues remained hubs of activity. Judges and student coordinators monitored both events, evaluating the Free Fire teams based on performance and the Escape Room participants based on logic and completion time.

### **Vote of Thanks**

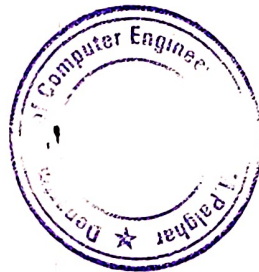
