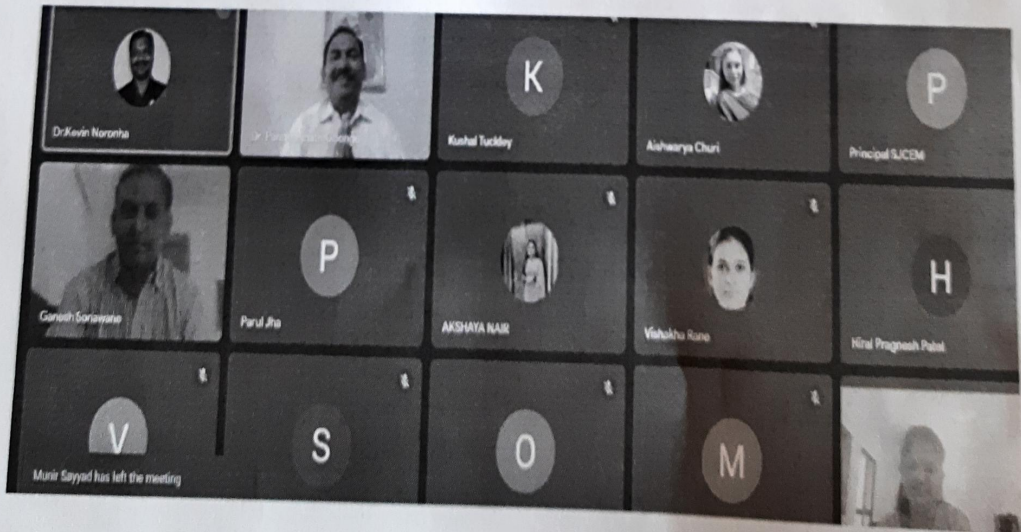
Minutes of Department Advisory Board (DAB) Meeting for Department of Electronics and Computer Science

Agenda 2: To understand the requirements from industry in latest technology and skillset expected from passing students.


Interdisciplinary Skills should be improved by running the parallel courses in the field of AIML, Blockchain, Cybersecurity. More students should take part in Hackathon.

Agenda 3: To discuss and review the Academic productivity in classroom and laboratory to meet the requirement of Outcome based Education


The BoS member suggested the use of different pedagogies in teaching and continuous assessment to ensure overall development of students
