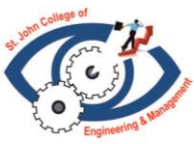
5.4.1 - There is a registered Alumni Association that contributes significantly to the development of the institution through financial and/or other support services.

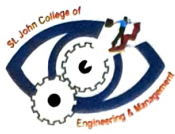
