17.2 Notification

In the event of a Force Majeure occurrence, the affected party shall promptly notify the other party in writing of the occurrence of such an event, the nature of the Force Majeure, and its estimated duration. The affected party shall use all reasonable efforts to mitigate the effects of the Force Majeure and resume performance of their obligations as soon as possible.

17.3 Suspension of Obligations

During the period of Force Majeure, the obligations of the affected party under this MoU shall be suspended to the extent they are affected by the Force Majeure event. The affected party shall not be liable for any delay or failure in the performance of its obligations to the extent caused by the Force Majeure.

17.4 Termination due to Force Majeure event

If a Force Majeure event continues for a period exceeding [Number] days, either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice to the other party. In such a case, any outstanding obligations or payments that have accrued up to the date of termination shall be settled as per the terms of this MoU.

B. Rigel Infotech, Mumbai, provides IT solutions to national & international clients, extends assistance in research work and provides training for institutes and corporates to enhance the research in the field of Computer Science and Application. Rigel Infotech is registered under MSME India with reg. no. UDYAM-MH-17-0067406 and is registered internship partner with AICTE.

C. The Parties wish to co-operate with each other as per the terms and conditions enumerated in this MoU.

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES SET FORTH THEIR PRELIMINARY UNDERSTANDING AS FOLLOWS:

1. SCOPE

1.1 The scope of this MoU is to provide a framework of reference to build a strong and on-going relationship between St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar and Rigel Infotech in various areas of mutual interest and benefit.

1.5 Any concept or design or new software product shall be sole property of second party. All copyrights pertaining to any design or product are solely owned by the Second Party. Second Party retains the sole and executive authority to use, sell, reproduce, or create derivatives in part or full. First Party hereby agrees not to share or copy or reproduce the design, in part or full, without written consent of Second Party

2. COORDINATION

2.1 St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar and Rigel Infotech will establish a "Core Consulting Team". Both the parties shall ensure that the "Core Consulting Team" comprises appropriate personnel to discuss and implement the ideas. Both sides will also have a Single Point of Contact for coordinating various activities and for administration purposes.

2.2 St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar shall be represented by its Head of Department with designated members from college as and when necessary.

2.3 The parties hereby acknowledge and agree that "Core Consulting Team" will meet at least once in three months (every quarter) to ensure successful implementation of all measures mutually agreed to in the areas mentioned in this document for which the date can be agreed mutually.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar

3.1 To provide the name of participants who will be taking training from Rigel Infotech

3.2 To provide technical assistance working in the computer lab during training.

3.3 Maintain key S/V provided by Rigel Infotech. It is understood that Rigel Infotech will provide the latest versions of the Software, Hardware and tools if required.

3.4 If required Rigel Infotech's consulting engineer will visit college for consulting purposes, College can provide local logistic arrangements for engineers for a reasonable and mutually agreed period to carry out consulting activity at St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF RIGEL INFOTECH

4.1 To provide industry experts to support and conduct consulting activity or training.

4.2 To train St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar students and/or faculties on best industry practices and develop competency at St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar premises wherein the remuneration of such Workshop/FDP/Seminar/Internship or any other events will be decided on mutual understanding of both the parties.

5. JOINT RESPONSIBILITIES OF ST. JOHN COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND MANAGEMENT

5.1 Both parties jointly agree to closely work together to bring Workshop/Training opportunities for Students and Faculties.

5.2 Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) of five days once every year will be supported by Rigel Infotech.

5.3 In case of additional funding required to develop expertise on consulting, St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar and Rigel Infotech will put up a joint project proposal for funding by govt or any other agencies.

5.4 To work towards the success of projects and relationship fostering.

6. TERMS AND TERMINATION

6.2 On mutual agreement after a period of 5 years, MoU can be further extended.

6.3 Either party shall have the right to terminate this MoU by giving 30 days prior written notice to the other Party.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY


7.1 Neither party shall, without the prior written consent of the other party, disclose to any third party the contents of this MoU or any information obtained by either party in performance of or in connection with this MoU. Both the parties agree to take all reasonable measures to maintain the confidentiality of all such Confidential Information which in no event will be less than the measures it uses to maintain the confidentiality of its own information of similar importance.

7.2 The obligations of confidentiality shall come into effect upon the signing of this MOU and shall survive even after the termination of this MoU.

8. COMMERCIALS

The commercials for each consulting opportunity will be discussed and agreed upon by both parties on a case-to-case basis.

9. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

10.2 Both parties shall be liable for direct, loss, damage, cost or expense of any kind whatsoever and however caused whether arising under statute, contract and tort or otherwise in this MoU.

11. ARBITRATION

11.1 In the event of any dispute or differences arising at any time between the Parties hereto as to the construction, meaning or effect of this agreement or any clause or thing contained herein or the rights, duties, liabilities and obligations of the parties hereto or breach thereof, the parties shall in good faith endeavor to resolve the dispute by mutual discussion

11.2 In the event, the parties are unable to do so, the matter will be settled by arbitration subject to the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and as amended from time to time.

11.3 The Parties shall mutually agree to endeavor to appoint a single arbitrator from St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar, within a period of 30 days. The appointed arbitrator will be referred for resolution. The arbitration proceedings will be held at Palghar and Palghar District Court will have Jurisdiction to resolve the matter.

12. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION.

12.1 This MOU shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of India. Any dispute arising in connection therewith shall be submitted only to Palghar Court and Palghar Court has Jurisdiction to resolve the matter.

13. NON SOLICITATION

13.1 St. John College of Engineering and Management, Palghar shall directly or indirectly solicit, or cause to be solicited the employment of any employee of Rigel Intotech, who is involved in the performance of its obligations under this MoU.

14. BINDING


